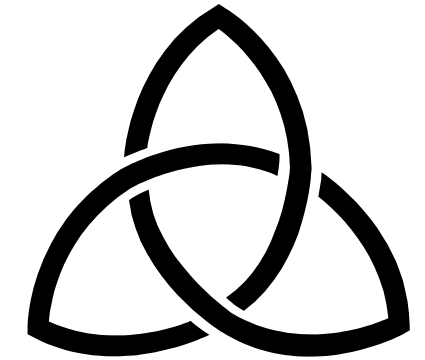

**Ash Wednesday and Lenten midweek worship begin this week, February 17th.** For nine centuries Christians have gathered together on Ash Wednesday to mark the start of Lent. Ash Wednesday is 40 days before Easter Sunday (not counting the Sabbath Rest on Sundays). The 40 days remind us of Jesus' fasting 40 days in the wilderness after His baptism. We have two worship opportunities on Ash Wednesday, at 5:30 pm and 7:00 pm. Holy Communion will be celebrated at both services, as well as the imposition of the cross of ashes on our foreheads, symbolizing our Lord's sacrifice and forgiveness of our sins. Wednesday Lenten services begin the following week. The worship services begin at 7:00 pm and are preceded by a light fellowship meal and refreshments afterwards. The theme for this year is:

Lent II March 3 *Illness and Death Pay a Visit*
