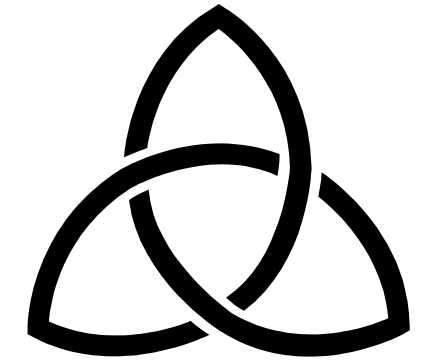

Grief, It Ain't No 100 yd. Dash

Once again Trinity Lutheran Church is privileged to host Dr. Harold Ivan Smith, on **March 13th** 9 – noon. This will be a free workshop for individuals who are grieving or who are helping others with their grief process.

Our culture is impatient with grievers. We want them to "Move Along!" and we assure them that they will be "fine in no time." This workshop will also look at ways that you can reach out to a griever. Practical ways that you can make a difference will be explored.

Dr. Smith is a graduate of the Mid-America College of Funeral Services, Scarritt College (M.A.), George Peabody College of Vanderbilt University (Ed. S.) and has a doctorate from the Asbury Theological Seminary. He leads Grief Gatherings at Saint Luke's Hospital in Kansas City and has authored numerous children and adult books on death and grieving.
